- The elegant lakefront Lodge offers a stunning Great Room with a beautiful slate fireplace and a view of Neva Lake.
- The Lodge has a hot tub available for guests' use.
- The Log Cabins are spacious and can accommodate up to six guests—perfect for families or couples seeking more space. Each Log Cabin has two bedrooms, two full baths, full-size kitchen, fireplace, TV/VCR, a large cedar deck, and an outdoor fire ring with a grill and picnic table.
- The Lake House is an upscale vacation home with three bedrooms, a loft sleeping area, three bathrooms with two Jacuzzi bathtubs, full-size kitchen, dining room, living room with fireplace, large cedar deck overlooking Neva Lake, and an outdoor fire ring with a picnic table.
- Custom-built Canvas Cabins offer a unique, upscale camping experience where campers can sleep on comfortable beds with luxurious linens and relax on beautiful hickory furniture. Each 225-square-foot Canvas Cabin was ecologically designed by Rainier Industries of Seattle, utilizing a sturdy wooden frame and floor topped with high-quality canvas. Each canvas cabin features a queen bed with cotton bed linens, bath linens, a table and four chairs, one cordless lantern and storage. The cabins are also furnished with either a full-size sleeper sofa or lounge chairs. Outside each Cabin are two Adirondack chairs with ottomans, a picnic table and a fire ring.

- The General Store, open seasonally, stocks groceries, wine, beer, camping and fishing gear, bait, ice and wood. It also serves Starbucks coffee.
