

# COUTURE CAMPING: LAKEDALE RESORT ANNOUNCES "GLAMPING" SURVIVAL KITS

- **Epicturean:** A collection of culinary tools and cookware designed for the gourmet camper with special features such as strainer-integrated pot lids; insulated compactable mugs; waterproof salt and pepper shakers; collapsible spoon and spatula and a welded sink that doubles as the stuff sack. \$100
- **Picnic Party Pack:** A deluxe table setting for four; a bundle of firewood with fire starter; a bag of ice; one-hour rowboat rental and a Lakedale Frisbee. \$65

The Lakedale "glampground" is open annually from May 1 to September 30. "Glamping" rates start at \$149 a night. Each custom built 225-square-foot canvas cabin features a queen bed with pillow-top bedding, a full-size sleeper sofa or two lounge chairs, pillows and a flannel duvet, a table and four chairs, one cordless lantern and bath linens. Every "glampsite" also includes two Adirondack chairs, a picnic table and a fire ring. Continental breakfast is included.
