



OVERVIEW

- Lakedale Resort, nestled between Roche Harbor and Friday Harbor on San Juan Island in Washington state, is accessible via a serene ferry ride or a quick floatplane trip from Seattle.
- Set on 82 wooded acres including Neva Lake, Dream Lake and Fish Hook Lake, Lakedale Resort provides an abundance of outdoor activities from biking, hiking and fishing to swimming, canoeing, kayaking and boating.
- One of Lakedale’s canvas cabins was featured on the cover of *Sunset* magazine’s May 2011 issue and in the article “Camping in Comfort”, and the campground and log cabins have been consistently ranked at the top of their categories in KING5’s Best of Northwest Escapes Viewers Poll.
- Lakedale Resort is owned by John and Shelley Bogaert and managed by Seattle-based Columbia Hospitality.

ACCOMMODATIONS

- Lakedale Resort offers six accommodation options: The Lodge, with cozy, romantic guestrooms; family-friendly log cabins; a multi-room Lake House, campsites for nature lovers; luxury camping in custom canvas cabins, the first in the Northwest; and a vintage Airstream trailer.
 - The elegant lakefront Lodge offers 10 well-appointed guestrooms in addition to a stunning Great Room with a beautiful slate fireplace and a view of Neva Lake.
 - Log cabins are spacious and can accommodate up to six guests—perfect for families or couples seeking more space. Each log cabin has two bedrooms, two full baths, a full-size kitchen, fireplace, TV/VCR, a large cedar deck, and an outdoor fire ring with a grill and picnic table.
 - The three-bedroom, three-bath Lake House accommodates up to six guests and is canine friendly. With a full-service kitchen, dining room and fireplace, and deck overlooking the lake, the Lake House is an upscale vacation home.
 - Custom-built canvas cabins offer a unique, upscale camping experience, often referred to as “glamping” or glamorous camping, where campers can sleep on comfortable beds with luxurious linens and relax on beautiful hickory furniture. There are 12 Standard Canvas Cabins, one Duplex Site comprised of two standard canvas cabins rented as a pair, a 450-square-foot Canvas Bunkhouse that can accommodate groups up to six people, and one Canvas Cottage featuring a king bed, full bathroom and a cozy lakeside setting.
 - A fully-equipped, vintage 1978 Sovereign Airstream trailer offers a waterfront accommodation for parties up to four.

AMENITIES

- The Lodge has a hot tub available for guests’ use.
- The General Store, open seasonally, stocks groceries, wine, beer, camping and fishing gear, bait, ice and wood. It also serves Starbucks coffee.
- With an abundance of natural habitat preserved throughout the resort, guests may observe otters, bald eagles and a variety of other creatures.

MEETINGS AND RETREATS

- Lakedale offers the ideal setting for meetings in the Lodge Dining Room and Grand Lobby. The adjoining deck provides additional meeting and reception options. Lakedale can accommodate groups from four to 20.
- Team-building activities include swimming, fishing, canoeing, sea kayaking, whale watching, bicycling, winery trips and local artisan tours.
- Lakedale offers audio-visual equipment, meeting supplies, meals and snacks and other services to ensure that meetings and retreats run smoothly from start to finish.
