ACCOMMODATIONS

Palm Mountain Resort's 142 graciously appointed guestrooms and suites offer a variety of options, most of which are generously sized and feature private patios or balconies. Each room boasts amenities such as luxury linens, flat-screen TVs, and Wi-Fi. Five room types suit the needs of a range of travelers:

- Garden View rooms are approximately 260 square feet and provide a view of the lush grounds and the choice of a king bed or two double beds. Many feature a private balcony or patio.
- Upscale Pool View rooms are approximately 260 square-feet and feature pool views from a private balcony or patio. These guestrooms offer a king bed or two double beds.
- Premium Pool View rooms are approximately 340 square-feet and feature spectacular pool views from a private balcony or patio. These spacious guestrooms feature a king bed or two double beds.
- The Atrium Building rooms are approximately 360 square-feet, featuring patios. These over-sized rooms offer and a king bed or two double beds.
- Suites are approximately 420 square-feet and include a king bed and sitting area. These gracious accommodations also offer semi-private or private patios.
